RISCA BEACH PARTY Saturday 8th June & Sunday 9th June 2024

LOCATION: Tredegar Park, Tredegar Street, Risca.

OPENING TIMES: 10.00am - 4.00pm

ROAD CLOSURES, CAR PARK CLOSURES & TRAFFIC SYSTEMS: The event is held in Tredegar Park and therefore no road closures are required. There is no impact to the traffic systems within the town centre whilst the event is taking place.

RESIDENT & RETAILER ACCESS: The event is held in Tredegar Park and there is no impact on access for residents or retailers to their properties.

TAXIS: Taxis are unaffected by the event.

BUS STOPS/ROUTE: Bus stops are unaffected by the event.

BARGOED SUMMER MUSIC FESTIVAL Saturday 6th July 2024

LOCATION: Lowry Plaza, Hanbury Square, Hanbury Road, High Street and Upper High Street.

OPENING TIMES: 9.00am - 7.30pm

ROAD CLOSURES, CAR PARK CLOSURES & TRAFFIC SYSTEMS: A full road closure of Hanbury Square, Hanbury Road, High Street and Upper High Street from 9.00pm on 05.07.24 until 11.00pm on 06.07.24. Emporium Car park will close at 9pm on 05.07.24 until 11pm on 06.07.24. All vehicles must be removed from the car park before the closure is in place. Suitable safety vehicles will be placed on all vehicle entry points onto the event site. This vehicle mitigation creates a safe event environment for the event to take place and forms part of the event counter terrorism plan.

RETAILER ACCESS: Please arrange deliveries prior to 9.00pm on 05.07.24 and after 11.00pm on 06.07.24 or between 3.00am - 7.00am. There is no access to HGV vehicles in the town centre during the road closure period.

RESIDENT ACCESS: No parking is permitted on Hanbury Square, Hanbury Road, High Street and Upper High Street from 9.00pm on 05.07.24 until 11.00pm on 06.07.24. Alternative parking arrangements must be made. A diversionary route around the town centre will be in place for the duration of the road closure. Residents of West Street, Cross Street and Capel Street will need to use alternative routes. No access will be permitted onto Hanbury Road from 9.00pm on 05.07.24 until after 11.00pm on 06.07.24.

TAXIS: Taxis are not permitted through the road closure area. Please arrange alternative collection and drop off sites.

BUS STOPS/ROUTE: All buses will operate directly to/from Bargoed Interchange and will not serve Hanbury Square or Royal Square. Buses on route C18 and X38 will operate via Wood Street, Ruth Street and Henry Street and will not serve Hanbury Square, Royal Square or The Plasnewydd.

BLACKWOOD BEACH PARTYSaturday 13th July 2024

LOCATION: High Street, Blackwood. **OPENING TIMES:** 9.00am - 5.00pm

ROAD CLOSURES, CAR PARK CLOSURES & TRAFFIC SYSTEMS: A closure of High Street from its junction with Bridge Street and Pentwyn Road from 9.00pm on 12.07.24 until 9.00pm on 13.07.24. Bridge Street and Pentwyn Road will remain open. Wesley Car Park is inaccessible during the event for the general public from 9pm on 12.07.24 to 9pm on 13.07.24. Suitable safety vehicles will be placed on all vehicle entry points onto the event site. This vehicle mitigation creates a safe event environment for the event to take place and forms part of the event counter terrorism plan.

RETAILER ACCESS: Retailers that do not have rear lane access off the road closure area on Blackwood High Street should arrange deliveries required during the event weekend to be made prior to 9.00pm on 12.07.24 or between 3.00am - 7.00am on 13.07.24.

RESIDENT ACCESS: Wesley Road residents will be issued with passes to gain access to their property via Cefn Road from 9.00pm on 12.07.24 until 9.00pm on 13.07.24. This is the only access route to your property during the road closure period and passes must be visible on entry. The barrier will be unlocked for the duration of the road closure and manned by a steward during the event opening hours. Security will partially monitor the barrier overnight. If unmanned when you access/egress the site, please ensure the barrier is kept closed afterwards. If you require additional passes, please contact events@caerphilly.gov. uk / 07876 358074. Please note that Wesley Car Park will remain a pay and display car park even though access to the car park is limited; if you do park here, please ensure you adhere to the fees indicated on the pay and display notices.

TAXI: No taxis are permitted through the road closure area. Please arrange alternative collection and drop off sites.

BUS STOPS/ROUTE: Bus stops are unaffected by the road closure. Alternative routes around Gordon Road, Albany Road, Attlee Road, Bloomfield Road, Pentwyn Road and Pentwyn Avenue will operate.



CAERPHILLY CHEESE FESTIVAL Saturday 31st August & Sunday 1st September 2024

LOCATION: Cardiff Road, Twyn Road, Castle Street (Northbound carriageway only), Dafydd Williams Park, Rear of Caerphilly Castle (Grassed area on castle side of Crescent Road), Lon Y Twyn Road, Castle Court Shopping Centre and Twyn Car Park.

OPENING TIMES: 9am - 8pm on Saturday 31st August and 9am - 5pm on Sunday 1st September.

ROAD CLOSURES, CAR PARK CLOSURES & TRAFFIC **SYSTEMS:** A closure of Cardiff Road, Twyn Road, Lon Y Twyn Road and Castle Street (Northbound carriageway only) from 9.00pm on 30.08.24 until 9.00pm on 01.09.24 St Fagan's Street one way system will be removed during the road closure between its junction with Bradford Street and Cardiff Road. Vehicles must take a left turn when driving from St Fagan's Street to Bradford Street. Pentrebane Street vehicle mitigation will be placed by The Hive Tuition Centre to incorporate the businesses located on this street into the event site. St Fagans Street vehicle mitigation will be placed beyond Peacocks /The Deli to incorporate these businesses into the event site. A number of no waiting comes will be placed just beyond Peacocks / The Deli by residential properties to create a turning circle for any vehicles entering St Fagan's Street from its junction with Bradford Street. Twyn Car Park closes at 4pm for the event set up on 30.08.24 until 9pm on 01.9.24. Suitable safety vehicles will be placed on all vehicle entry points onto the event site. This vehicle mitigation creates a safe event environment for the event to take place and forms part of the event counter terrorism plan.

LONYTWYN ROAD: Lon Y Twyn road will be closed from 9.00pm on 30.08.24 until 9.00pm on 01.09.24 to accommodate Brew Monster hosting their own event during the Caerphilly Cheese Festival and there will be a prohibition of waiting and loading. To facilitate a safe event residents and retailers are requested to keep this road and all car parks located off this road clear of vehicles. Where vehicles are parked in the rear lane from East View to Lon Y Twyn it is advised that all vehicles are parked to exit via East View. There will be no entry onto Lon Y Twyn Road from this lane during the closure. Where alternative car parking cannot be sourced for those retailers with car parks on Lon Y Twyn Road the Twyn School can be used for parking during the event opening hours each day if required. RETAILER ACCESS: Retailers that do not have rear lane access on the road closure area on Cardiff Road should arrange deliveries required for the event weekend to be made prior to 9.00pm 30.08.24 or between 3.00am - 7.00am on 31.08.24 and 01.09.24. St Fagan's Street retailers that have parking / garage space at the rear of their properties on Park Lane will be issued with passes for access during the event. Twyn School can be used for parking during the event opening hours each day if required and if in receipt of a pass. Retailers and Library staff that are permitted access to the car park at the rear of Principality Building Society and Caerphilly Library can request access passes by contacting events@caerphilly.gov.uk / 07876 358074.

ICELAND DELIVERY SERVICE, NICOLA DOWNIE FLORIST & SPORTS DIRECT CAR PARK: Access is not permitted to the general public into the car park. A steward will monitor

the lockable drop-down bollards between Windsor Street and Sports Direct / Nicola Downie Florist / Iceland car park during the event. Any taxi requirements will need to arrange collection from the end of the Windsor Street North Urban Lane. Iceland,

Nicola Downie Florist and Sports Direct key holders, managers and early shift workers can access the car park via Cardiff Road from 3.00am until 7.00am on 31.08.24 and 01.09.24. After these times vehicles will only be permitted to leave the store car park via Windsor Street North Urban Lane. All other staff should park in alternative car parks in the vicinity or there is provision at Twyn School. Passes will be issued to Sports Direct, Nicola Downie Florist and Iceland for this school. For any on the day queries, please call 07876 358074 for the onsite event officer.

RESIDENT ACCESS: To facilitate a safe passage for Iceland, Nicola Downie Florist and Sports Direct delivery vehicles through Windsor Street North Urban Lane, residents are requested to keep this lane free of vehicles during the event period. There will be a prohibition of waiting and loading in this lane from 5.00pm 30.08.24 until 9.00pm on 01.09.24. St Fagan's Street residents that have parking / garage space at the rear of their properties on Park Lane will be issued with passes for access during the event. Twyn School can be used for parking during the event opening hours each day if required.

TAXI: No taxis are permitted through the road closure area. Please arrange alternative collection and drop off sites.

BUS STOPS/ROUTE: Bus stops affected by the closure will be moved to the main interchange and an alternative route along Clive Street, Ludlow Street and Crescent Road will operate.
